

Friston Baptist Church

The following is a list of arrangements and precautionary measures that have been put in place following the completion of a Covid-19 risk assessment for Friston Baptist Church.

God willing, there will be a Lord's Day morning service at 10:45 a.m. and also an afternoon service, both services will be relayed via Zoom. The Prayer and Bible Study meeting held on a Tuesday evening will continue to be held via ZOOM for the time being. Sunday School will be held once on Lord's Days in the side rooms.

The arrangements detailed below only apply to meetings held at Friston Baptist Chapel.

1. Please do not enter the building or premises if you have a high temperature, a new continuous cough or a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste.
2. All toilet facilities are available for use. Hand sanitiser should be used before and after entering the toilet facilities.
3. Those attending services are asked to be respectful to those who may wish to keep a distance from others and/or wear a mask.
4. Hand sanitization should be undertaken on entering the Sanctuary. The wearing of a face mask or covering is required at special services where the sanctuary is crowded or where large numbers of visitors attend. Children under the age of 11 are not required to wear a face covering.
5. Personal possessions taken into the Chapel should be kept to a minimum. They must be kept within the attendees designated seating area, i.e. Bibles, coats etc. Sunday school materials will be provided but sharing materials between households should be avoided.
6. The Sanctuary will be well ventilated through the opening of windows, and the main Chapel door when possible.
7. Freewill offerings on Sundays may be made at any time into receptacles provided or by online bank transfer.

These arrangements will be kept under review. It may be that we will have to suspend services again in the event of a worsening of the Coronavirus situation. We pray for the Lord's blessing on all who worship Him, both at Friston and in their own homes via ZOOM.
